Description

Administered through The Security Officer Network's custom curriculum and assessment portal, the Hazardous Material Classification Systems 101 course provides a high-level, introductory overview of the DOT Hazmat, NFPA '704 and OSHA HazCom labeling systems.

Objectives

Upon completion of the course, the participant should:

Identify and attribute the signage elements of the three hazardous material classification systems;

Have an awareness for the common uses of hazardous material labeling;

Know how to retrieve and maintain access to the hazardous material classification codes; and

Develop a familiarity with the role played by a hazardous material security expert and explore the possibility of an occupation future in this security niche.

Requirements

The participant must submit five reading assignments and complete a five-question timed assessment.

Level

This is a basic, first-level course; it is suitable for all participants.
